

Application requirements

- Academic transcripts (UG and PG)
- English language (IELTS, TOEFL iBT)
- CV/resume
- Initial statement of research intent
 - Not a full thesis proposal at this stage
- Arrange for 2 academic references to be sent
 - Masters thesis supervisor

- Design bio-based antimicrobial delivery system for improving the safety and quality of raw or minimally processed food products
- Develop antifouling and antimicrobial food-contact materials to eliminate the risk of microbial contamination
- Discover nature inspired compositions for improving stability of biological control agents for agricultural and aquaculture applications
- Develop nonthermal food processing technologies for improving the safety and quality of food products
